



Number of households/Partner Family for each year: 225-282



- Timeline: starting from March 23rd, 2020




- 2nd year and 3rd year students (medical, nursing and nutrition)













Progress on implementing program



CHALLENGES & SOLUTIONS

- Partner families don't have mobile phones and WhatsApp applications → we extend to other families
- Partner families do not provide feedback when contacted by students

 distribute assisted online feedback form
- Partner families refuse to contribute \rightarrow we recruit another families
- Partner families are busy > we give more times and supervision






Percentage who filled out the CFHC-IPE online education evaluation form about Covid-19





Percentage of Partner Families (batch 2017 and 2018) who filled out the CFHC-IPE online education evaluation form and screening form of Covid-19




